BIRDSEED AND CRANBERRY ICE

Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they

cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat Observe that some materials change state when

they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C)





ACTIVITY:

Fill an ice cube tray 1/3 of the way with cranberries and add a twine loop, knot down, for hanging on a branch.

Fill the remaining space with birdseed, then add water until there is a thin layer covering all the ingredients. Put the ice cube tray outdoors on a frosty night OR in the freezer overnight. Remove ice ornaments from molds, hang on a tree and enjoy watching the birds feed

To make an ice ring place twine loop and a cup inside a bowl. Fill the bowl with an inch or so of water. Add bird seed and cranberries and again place outside or in freezer overnight.

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
