YEAR GROUP: Lower KS2

CURRICULUM LINKS:

Science – recognise that plants can be grouped into categories; identify local fauna.



PSHE – recognize personal qualities that make you special as a person and understand that we are all unique.

- recognize the way that we are the same as and different from others.

ACTIVITY:

To create a natural bouquet, including as many different types, shapes, textures and colours of vegetation.

To admire the uniqueness of others and reflect on your own unique qualities.

HOW TO:

Take a walk around you wild area noticing and identifying the wide range of wild grasses and plants growing. Look for grasses and plants of different sizes, textures e.g. shiny, hairy, tickly, scratchy... Look for grasses without seeds. Look for grasses with different seed heads. Look for different colours or shades of a colour.

Mindfully, respecting the environment, gather a variety of stems into a bunch and tie together.

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
