## TREE IDENTIFICATION NAIL BOARDS SPRING

**YEAR GROUP:** Lower KS2

### **CURRICULUM LINKS:**

**Science** – Identify common trees, the functions of different parts and seasonal changes.

**Maths** – Explore geometric shapes; investigate triangles and angles.



### **ACTIVITY:**

#### **Resources:**

Wooden boards or large log slices  
Hammer  
Flat head nails  
Green and brown wool or embroidery threads or elastic bands.

### **HOW TO:**

Identify trees in your locality by leaf, fruit and overall shape. Explore the 'parts' of the tree and their function and recognise seasonal changes. Record tree shape onto log slice or wooden board. Hammer flat head nails around the tree outline. Use threads or bands to explore geometric patterns whilst gaining familiarity with tree identification by silhouette.

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
